Brothers,

As of September 1, 2008, the Knights of Columbus has introduced a new "New Member Plan". The plan is an annuity contract to which the New Member can make a contribution of \$100.00 and immediately become an Insurance Member of our Order. The Member will receive the current interest rate that is being paid for that calendar quarter guaranteed to the start of the same quarter next year. For example, a member buys the new "New member

Plan" on August 1, 2008. The current interest rate of 4.50% will be paid until June 30, 2009. The calendar *quarter* would be July 1, 2008 – June 30, 2009.

This plan is to be executed on a new form 100 which are now available through the Supply Department; make sure you order ample copies and destroy the older form 100's. As of January 1, 2009, the \$50.00 a year New Member Insurance Plan will be no longer available.



Faithful Navigator's Report

Brother Sir Knights,

The month of October is upon us, and so is Columbus Day, the day in which we commemorate the discovery of the New World by the explorer, Christopher Columbus. As we well know, our Order is named after him, but what most of the history books fail to mention is that he was a devout Roman Catholic. Columbus believed he was specially chosen by God to bring the Gospel to a people who were living in darkness and the shadow of death. He was a

Third Order Franciscan, who believed that the world should be converted to Christ by prayer, preaching, and peaceful means. His journal is a daily record of the historic voyage from Spain to the New Indies. Day after day, he refers to Jesus and the need for divine help. He was always asking Our Lord for the light and strength he needed to realize what God had entrusted him to do – the mission of bringing the knowledge and love of Jesus and Mary to the multitudes who had not had the Good News of salvation brought to them.

Let us pray for the courage to do the same for those around us, proudly, as Knights of Columbus.

McGivney Hall dedicated at Catholic University

On September 8th, the Catholic University of America rededicated one of its prominent academic buildings after a renovation funded by the Knights of Columbus. The building has been renamed McGivney Hall in honor of Venerable Servant of God, Father Michael J. McGivney, the founder of our Order.

The Knights of Columbus has a long tradition of providing support for CUA for over a century, beginning with a \$55,000 contribution in 1904 to endow a Chair in American History. In 1914 the Order provided CUA a \$500,000 endowment for fellowships and operating costs. In 1965, the organization established the Pro Deo and Pro Patria Scholarship Program to provide tuition assistance to Knights and family members. In 1989, the Knights created the \$2 million Bicentennial of the US Hierarchy Fund, proceeds of which financed construction of the law school building.

The five-story limestone structure was originally built in 1958 as the CUA's physics research facility. It will serve as the home for the North American session of the Pontifical John Paul II Institute for Studies on Marriage and Family, a graduate school of theology, also affiliated with the Pontifical Lateran University in Rome.

Order Mourns Passing of Jean Migneault

Jean Migneault, former Deputy Supreme Knight passed away September 4 in Montreal. He was 67 years old. Migneault served as Deputy Supreme Knight from 2000 until his retirement in 2006. Previous to that he was Supreme Treasurer and Assistant Supreme Treasurer, and served on the Board of Directors from 1984 to 2006.

Supreme Knight Carl A. Anderson praised Migneault, "The Knights of Columbus mourns the loss of a true friend and outstanding fraternal leader who served our membership for many years in a dedicated spirit of service, while overseeing the growth of the Order in Canada. Jean Migneault was a man of great faith and charity who was a personal friend, and he provided me with invaluable advice throughout our years of working together."

Born in the Quebec in 1941, Migneault was in the banking industry before being appointed Assistant Supreme Treasurer of the Knights of Columbus in 1992. In 1997 he was elected Supreme Treasurer, serving three years before becoming Deputy Supreme Knight. Over the years, he received numerous honors for his fraternal, charitable and religious works.

Thank you to the Brother Knights and Squires who helped spread mulch at the Saint Joseph Playground on Saturday September 13th. Helping others and the community are what we stand for.
